At a session of the Leelanau County Apportionment Commission, held on June 2, 2011, at the Leelanau County Government Center, the following motion was passed:

MOTION BY LIND TO ADOPT AND FILE WITH THE LEELANAU COUNTY CLERK, A SEVEN COMMISSIONER DISTRICT APPORTIONMENT PLAN, REFERRED TO AS PLAN #14, FOR THE NEXT TEN (10) YEARS, BASED ON THE 2010 CENSUS DATA. SECOND JOHNSON.

DISTRICT #1 Population – 3097

- **All that part of City of Traverse City within Leelanau County**
- **That portion of Elmwood Township described as:** all households south of the centerline of E. Fouch Rd. (beginning at the west township line) and south of the centerline of E. Cherry Bend Rd. to its intersection with E. Strang Rd. and thence east along the south line of Parcel 45-004-020-011-00 extended to the east section line and thence north along the east section line to the water's edge of Cedar Lake; and all households lying southerly of the following described line: beginning on the shore of West Grand Traverse Bay on the north line of Parcel 45-004-021-005-00, thence west along the north line of Parcel 45-004-021-005-00 (crossing S. West-Bay Shore Dr.) to the centerline of the current private drive or easement (as of 2011 Apportionment) of said parcel and following said centerline northwesterly & southerly to its intersection with the water's edge of Cedar Lake.

DISTRICT #2 Population – 3001

- **That portion of Elmwood Township described as:** all households north of the centerline of E. Fouch Rd. (beginning at the west township line) and northerly of the centerline of E. Cherry Bend Rd. to its intersection with E. Strang Rd. and thence east along the south line of Parcel 45-004-020-011-00 extended to the east section line and thence north along the east section line to the water's edge of Cedar Lake; and all households lying northerly of the following described line: beginning on the shore of West Grand Traverse Bay on the north line of Parcel 45-004-021-005-00, thence west along the north line of Parcel 45-004-021-005-00 (crossing S. West-Bay Shore Dr.) to the centerline of the current private drive or easement (as of 2011 Apportionment) of said parcel and following said centerline northwesterly & southerly to its intersection with the water's edge of Cedar Lake.
- **That portion of Bingham Township described as:** all households lying southerly (including southwesterly & southeasterly) of the following described line: Parcels of land south of parcel 45-001-111-007-00 and east of road known as S. Grant's Landing, thence following said road northerly and thence east to its intersection with the centerline of S. Lake Leelanau Dr., thence following said road centerline northerly to the centerline of E. Otto Rd, thence east along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Maple Valley Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Otto Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Center Otto Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Otto Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Center Hwy. and S. Elm Valley Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Hill Top Rd., thence east along this

centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. West-Bay Shore Dr., thence northerly along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Lee Point Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with E. Hendryx Dr., thence east along this centerline & south line of parcel 45-001-011-003-50 to the shore of West Grand Traverse Bay.

DISTRICT #3 Population - 3127

- **That portion of Bingham Township described as:** all households lying northerly (including northwesterly & northeasterly) of the following described line: Parcels of land addressed off of S. Grant's Landing lying to the west of said road (the southerly-most being parcel 45-001-111-007-00), thence following said road north and east to its intersection with the centerline of S. Lake Leelanau Dr., thence following said road centerline northerly to the centerline of E. Otto Rd, thence east along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Maple Valley Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Otto Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Center Otto Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Otto Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Center Hwy. and S. Elm Valley Rd., thence south along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of E. Hill Top Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. West-Bay Shore Dr., thence northerly along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of S. Lee Point Rd., thence east along this centerline to its intersection with E. Hendryx Dr., thence east along this centerline & south line of parcel 45-001-011-003-50 to the shore of West Grand Traverse Bay.
- **That portion of Suttons Bay Township described as:** all households lying south or southerly and west or westerly of the following line: Beginning at the northwest corner of Suttons Bay Township, thence east along the centerline of E. Alpers Rd. to its intersection with the centerline of N. Setterbo Rd., thence southeasterly along this centerline to its intersection with the centerline of N. West-Bay Shore Dr. (St Hwy M-22), thence running northeasterly along centerline of N. West-Bay Shore Dr. to its intersection with the northerly right of way line of Jacobson Rd., thence southeasterly (along the northerly boundary of parcel 45-011-015-008-20) to the easterly line of the former Leelanau Transit Company Railroad right of way, thence northeasterly along this right of way to the northerly line of parcel 45-011-015-008-10, thence southeasterly (along the northerly line of parcel 45-011-015-008-10) to the shore of Suttons Bay (West Grand Traverse Bay).

DISTRICT 4 Population - 2976

- **That portion of Suttons Bay Township described as:** all households lying east and north of the following described line: commencing at the northwest corner of the township thence east along the north township line & centerline of E. Alpers Rd. to its intersection with centerline of N. Setterbo Rd. for the beginning and following said centerline of N. Setterbo Rd. southerly to its intersection with N. West-Bay Shore Dr. (St. Hwy. M-22), thence running northeasterly along centerline of N. West-Bay Shore Dr. to its intersection with the northerly right of way line of N. Jacobson Rd., thence southeasterly (along the northerly boundary of parcel 45-011-015-008-20) to the easterly line of the former Leelanau Transit Company Railroad right of way, thence northeasterly along this right of way to the northerly line of parcel 45-011-015-008-10, thence southeasterly (along the northerly line of parcel 45-011-015-008-10) to the shore of Suttons Bay (West Grand Traverse Bay).
