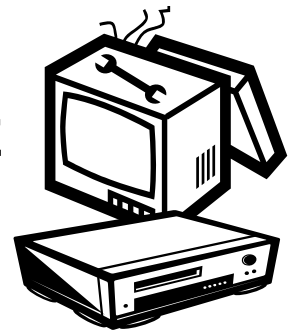

**Unacceptable Materials**

Latex Paint, Radioactive Material, Unknown/Unlabeled Wastes, Explosives, Shock-sensitive Materials, Tires, White Goods (Refrigerators and other items with Freon, Washers & Dryers, Water Softeners, other major appliances), Home Business Waste and Commercially Generated Waste **ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**

**AMMUNITION:** Contact the Sheriff's Department.

**LATEX PAINT: DO NOT** pour paint down the drain or on the ground. You can dispose of latex paint by allowing it to dry and then disposing of it in the trash—just take the lid off and let liquids evaporate. Or, to speed up the drying process, you can mix in equal amounts of kitty litter or vermiculite, or pour paint into a plastic-lined cardboard box in 1" thick layers. Let each layer dry and harden before pouring the next layer.
